

BIFA Standard Trading Conditions (STCS) – 2021 Edition

Addendum to BIFA Standard Trading Conditions (STCs) - 2021 Edition:

Effective from 26 October 2023.

The following amendments shall be incorporated into the BIFA STCs (E&W, NI, Scotland) as follows:

Data Protection

(A) In this clause:

(i) "Agreement" means any act or contract to which these conditions apply.

(ii) "Clarkson Affiliate" means any subsidiary (as defined at s.1159 Companies Act 2006) of Clarkson PLC that is a party (in whatever capacity) to an Agreement.

(iii) "Data Protection Legislation" means (as they relate to these conditions) (i) the General Data Protection Regulation (EU/2016/679) ("GDPR") and any relevant subordinate legislation in the UK unless and until the GDPR is no longer directly applicable in the UK, and then (ii) any successor legislation to the Data Protection Act 1988.

(iv) "Controller" and "Personal Data" have the meaning ascribed in the Data Protection Legislation.

(B) Each party will comply with its obligations under the Data Protection Legislation and will also provide reasonable assistance to the other party in that party's compliance with its obligations under the Data Protection Legislation.

(C) The Clarkson Affiliate acts as Controller in relation to Personal Data provided to it under an Agreement. Any provider of Personal Data to the Clarkson Affiliate will ensure that it is lawfully entitled to provide all such Personal Data to the Clarkson Affiliate and that the Clarkson Affiliate may lawfully use the same for and in the performance of the Agreement. The Clarkson Affiliate may not be instructed by the provider to delete any Personal Data that it holds.

Modern Slavery Act

(A) The Customer will comply with its obligations pursuant to the United Kingdom Modern Slavery Act 2015.
